The Brandon Veterans Memorial has four main polished stones, and under each of them the concrete is cracking. The approximate weight of each stone is 1,800 lbs.

Don Branson has a theory which he said, "Our ground around here is always moving, and I believe that has something to do with it."

This memorial is a corner stone in this community and we will not let it deteriorate like this without a fight. Please go out and have a look for yourselves and let
